Go4th Services: When should I stand or sit?

In a "formal" service, a hymn is a specific part of the service and there are protocols. We stand for hymns; we sit for prayers and the address.

Go4th is not formal. We don't sing "a hymn". There is no single "Address". We might sing three songs in a row, or one by itself. We might have prayer in the middle of a bunch of hymns. It is intended that we all have the freedom to stand, or sit, to sing whenever we feel like it, or to listen, to break off singing and pray during a song/hymn, if we wish.

The whole intention of Go4th is that there is no formal thing you should do. If you wish to sit, do so. If you want to stand, do so. If you want to pray, then pray.

Let go, and let God. It will be fine.
