Friday May 8th 2026



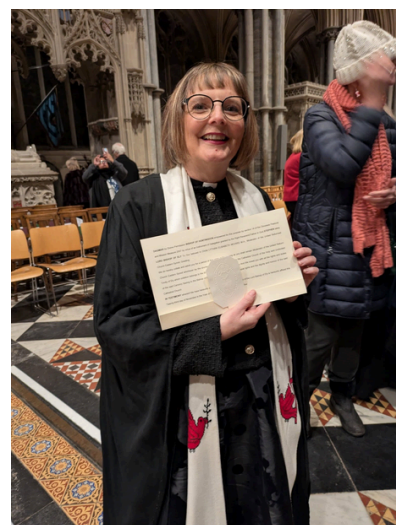
Men's Open Cafe
