



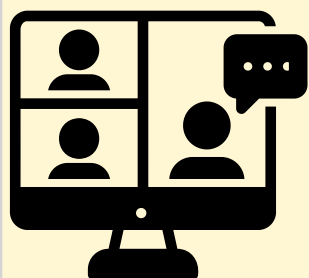

Building Free Villages
