When Abraham Joshua Heschel speaks of living life in “radical amazement,” he means cultivating the ability to be astonished by what we too easily take for granted. The world can become so familiar that we stop really seeing it: another sunrise, another person, another breath, another ordinary day.

For Heschel, faith begins when we recover our sense that existence itself is extraordinary. Worship, then, is not so much about escaping from ordinary life to find God somewhere else; it is about learning to pay attention until the ordinary becomes charged with wonder. To worship is to stop, notice, listen and allow ourselves to be surprised again by the mystery and gift of being alive.
